- 3. Statement of support from the applicant's home institution (if applicable)
- 4. Certificate of language skills (when required by the host institution)
- 5. Declaration of honour
- 6. Statement certifying the condition of Target Group III individual (if applicable)

These documents must be uploaded when filling in the online application form.

The application form will be available soon at the Partnership's website.

We strongly recommend the early organisation of all required documents, so as to make the application process as simple and efficient as possible.

In order to increase the chances of being selected we also recommend the applicants to choose 3 different European Higher Education institutions.
