

Dr Sanjay Singh qualified as a veterinary surgeon from Rajasthan University of Veterinary and Animal Science in 2016. Since 2016 he has worked as a veterinary surgeon at the animal welfare charity, Help in Suffering in Jaipur, India. His main professional interest is surgery, and he undertakes much of the surgical, managerial and monitoring work associated with the charity's street dog and rabies control programme.

Concerned about good antibiotic stewardship in the street dog and rabies control programme he changed the programme's protocol to stop the routine use of antibiotics. He presented a paper on the One Health results of the Jaipur Street dog and rabies control programme at the 3rd ICAM Dog Population Management conference in Kenya in 2019, and on antibiotic stewardship at an animal welfare conference in Cyprus 2023.
