Lance Price is a Professor at the Milken Institute School of Public Health at George Washington University and the Founding Director of the Antibiotic Resistance Action Center. Dr. Price works at the interface between laboratory research and public policy to address the growing crisis of antibiotic resistance. Prior to joining GW, Dr. Price directed the Center for Food Microbiology and Environmental Health at the Translational Genomics Research Institute. He received his PhD in Environmental Health Sciences from the Johns Hopkins Bloomberg School of Public Health, where he was a Center for a Livable Future Predoctoral Fellow.
