Fr Jim Keenan SJ: HIV/AIDS: The Expanding Ethical Challenge

Fr. James Keenan, SJ, is Professor of Theological Ethics at Boston College. He entered the New York Province of the Society of Jesus in 1970 and was ordained a priest in 1982. He studied moral theology at the Gregorian University in Rome with Frs. Josef Fuchs and Klaus Demmer and received a licentiate (1984) and a doctorate (1988). He edited *Practice What You Preach: Virtues, Ethics and Power in the Lives of Pastoral Ministers and Their Congregations* (2000) which won the Catholic Press Award for best work in Pastoral Theology and *Catholic Ethicists on HIV/AIDS Prevention* which won the best work in ethics from the Jesuit Honor Society, Alpha Sigma Nu, (2003). *The Works of Mercy: The Heart of Catholicism* is Father Keenan's newest book. He is now writing a book with Dr. Jon Fuller, SJ, on HIV/AIDS and the Catholic Church and another one with Daniel Harrington on Paul and Virtue Ethics.
